### Grand Traverse Resort and Spa Installs New Thermal Temperature Checks

ACME, Mich., July 7, 2020 – Guests visiting Grand Traverse Resort and Spa will now be required to have their temperature checked upon entry. Four new thermal self-check temperature stations have been installed at the entrances of the Grand Lobby, Health Club and Clubhouse.

“In order to stay open, we have to stay safe. This technology allows us to monitor who is coming in and out of our buildings while following the best health practices,” said Matthew Bryant, general manager of Grand Traverse Resort and Spa. “We want to ensure our guests can enjoy their visit and relax with confidence.”

The temperature stations are conveniently placed at main entry locations. Guests are required to stop in front of the tablets where their body temperature will be taken. If a guest’s temperature registers below 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit they will be allowed admittance. If their temperature is 100.4 or higher they will be denied entry. The machines also have a feature for mask detection. A guest temperature will only be read if they are wearing a face mask.

“We are getting busier and are happy to welcome people back to the Resort for the summer season, but we want everyone to remember we are still in the fight against COVID-19 and this extra step allows us to keep our properties open and community safe,” adds Bryant.

Guests should also continue to follow the recommended CDC guidelines:

- Wash your hands frequently, using soap and water, for at least 20 seconds.
- Stay home if you are sick.
- Cover your nose and mouth when you cough or sneeze and avoid touching your face.
- Avoid shaking hands and personal contact.

The thermal temperature stations are also being used at the Resort’s sister properties, Turtle Creek Casino & Hotel and Leelanau Sands Casino & Lodge.
