## **Bear Member Golf Updates**

## **Cart Rate Increase**

Bear Member per person golf rates will increase from \$22 to \$24 for 18-holes and from \$14 to \$15 for Twilight, 9-Holes or Replays for the 2022 golf season. These rates include the use of a golf cart as we have done in the past. The \$15 fee also applies to walking on Spruce Run. The Resort has not increased these rates since the 2017 season.

## Other Bear Member Related Golf Rates

Tuesday will continue to be Bear Member Guest Day, as Bear Member Guests will pay no more than \$40 for their 18-hole round on any course. In General, Bear Member Guests will continue to receive 50% off the Public Rack rates, or \$5 less than any golf special we may be running, whichever is lower.

## Bear Member Guests Golf Privileges – Five Time Limit per Season

A Member is entitled to have guests use the Club Facilities in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Club. The number

of times a guest may use Member Guest golf rate is limited to five (5) times per season. The Pro Shop staff are required to ask for the member guests names, so please be prepared to provide these names when reserving golf tee times or upon checking in for golf in the Pro Shop.

# Golf Association of Michigan (GAM) Memberships for 2022 – Activating your Handicap

You may have received an email or notification from the Golf Association of Michigan (GAM) about renewing your GAM membership online for an increased rate of \$41 in 2022, that is \$6 more than if you are paid thru your member account as we give you a \$6 discount per person for the annual membership. If you had a golf handicap thru GTRS in 2021 and wish to continue that in 2022, you do not need to do anything as Tom McGee has reactivated your account and GAM membership. If you had a GAM membership in 2021 but do not wish to have that or a USGA handicap thru them in 2022, please contact Tom to let him know and he will deactivate your GAM Membership. If you did not have a GAM Membership and golf handicap in 2021, but wish to start one, please contact Tom and he will get that set up for you. The \$35 per person annual fee will be billed to your member account in April 2022. Tom can be reached via email at tom.mcgee@gtresort.com.

- Golfers will continue to receive a Handicap Index® authorized by the USGA® as part of their GAM membership. This also includes access to

- Golfers who have not renewed online or have not been marked as "PAID" in GAM Club Admin will receive an email on January 6 alerting them
  - that they will be inactivated on January 10.
- Golfers who have not renewed online or have not been marked as "PAID" in GAM Club Admin will receive an email on January 10 alerting them
- that they are currently inactive.
- The online retail price is now \$41 to be a GAM Member.
